Pastor Kenny Carr asked the church family to begin to look for ways that we could minister to needs in our area and reach out while sharing the love of Christ. Below are some of the ways our church is being turned inside out.

**Community Ball Fields:** The 2 ball fields being built are simply a way to partner with the community as to needs for more fields. Tball and softball games and practices can be scheduled through Mrs. Jennifer Travis. There is no agenda other than to serve the community through these fields. We have been blessed with donations and materials from **Replogle Lumber, CSX Railroad, Old Hickory Clay Company, Carroll County Lumber, Brian Phillips and Chucky Greenway.** We still need lights to complete the fields. **D18:** Our Associate Pastor of Youth & Children, Greg Barker, leads this ministry where our youth meet at different member's homes as well as local businesses and consider ways their generation can live in strong in this present culture. D18 is taken from Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself.

**Grace Gardening:** This is a community Gardening Project led by one of our newest members, Jacob Harwell. This garden will be raised and maintained by several of our membership and all of the produce will be given away to those in need in many different ways. **Helping Hands Ministry:** This is a hot meal for the needy that feeds any and everyone who will come at the Shack (95 Doug Lane) on every 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month at 5 pm. There are several of the Long Heights Family that help with ministry and is primarily led by JC Popplewell's Sunday School Class. Please help us get the word out to anyone in need of a hot meal.

**LHBC Clothes Ministry:** For anyone needing clothing there is a great selection of clothing donated by the membership and others available on Sunday evenings at the Shack (95 Doug Lane) from 5-6 pm. We appreciate donations and ask that the donations not be clothes that are ready to throw away but what has been outgrown or is no longer worn. Chip Dunavan and Jerry and Willie Ruth Miller would be glad to help you.

**LHBC Food Ministry:** Lee and Teresa Jones lead this ministry and it is maintained also by donations from the membership and other ways of collection. On Wednesday evenings at 6 pm and Sunday evenings at 5 pm Deacons (Lee Jones, Bob Cole and Joe Lynn Dellinger), meet with those who are needing food and distribute and access food request.

**Oak Manor Bible Study:** Deacons Bob Cole and Joe Lynn Dellinger teach a bible study on Sunday evenings at the Oak Manor Nursing Home.

**Pitching & Hitting Lessons with the Word:** This is free pitching and hitting lessons with Long Heights members Kennedy White and Jacob Malone. On Sunday evenings from 6-7:30 pm the time is divided into a devotional time followed by fielding lessons and hitting lessons at the K's & W's, 18210 Thompson School Access Rd. in Huntingdon.

**Prison & Jail Ministry:** Chip Dunavan's and Paul Conquests class work together to minister to those incarcerated in local jails as well as those at the West Tennessee Correctional Institute.

**Samaritans Rest:** We are in the process of working out the specifics for a building to use to make 2 to 3 units for those who have been left homeless. This ministry is temporary housing for the community entities to use that are approached from time to time by people needing a place to stay.
